Each year Metro Radio support thousands of children from birth to 18 years old who are ill, disabled, underprivileged or who simply need extra care and guidance. They do this by providing grants to individual children, other children's charities, community groups, schools and health organisations.

Every penny raised locally stays locally, so you can be sure that your support will directly benefit a local child with a minimum of 80p from every pound donated going to the children.

Tanfield propose to support Cash for Kids through staff and pupil donations of unwrapped Christmas gifts for children aged 0-18.
