

## **Year 7 CATS Tests**

Hello,

This year has been unusual in many ways, one of which is that your child did not have the opportunity to participate in the end of year 6 SATS exams. The primary school teachers did a very good job of providing us with information about each child's strengths and areas to improve, but without being able to compare this information with the performance of students nationally, this leaves us at a disadvantage compared to previous years.

For this reason, like many schools across the country, we have decided to enter every year 7 students to do CATS tests. These are computer based tests which, unlike the SATS exams, give each student the opportunity to demonstrate their ability across a wide range of learning skills. Your child does not need to prepare in any way and they should come to school as normal. There is no need to worry about these tests and the overwhelming majority of students who participate in them describe them as fun and challenging.

Unlike formal SATS exams, there are no practice tests and no requirement for extra time to be assigned to any student.

The dates and times of these tests are as follows:

7ATH Monday 5th October, Lessons 2 and 3 7SLI Monday 5th October, Lessons 4 and 5 7ATO Tuesday 6th October, Lessons 2 and 3 7ADI Tuesday 6th October, Lessons 4 and 5

We will share the results of these tests with you and these will give a picture of your child's performance compared to the national performance.

Alongside other information, we will use these results to help us ensure that your child's progress throughout school can be tracked against students of the same ability nationally and this will help us ensure your child is working at a level which will meet or exceed this level.
