Dear Parent/Carer

Although it may seem a long time away, I thought it would be a good time to remind you and your child about our Summer Rewards Event (often referred to as The School Prom).

Every year, a greater proportion of our year 11 students are invited to attend our year 11 Summer Rewards event and this is because each year a greater proportion of students meet our criteria for attending. Your child was shown the criteria at the beginning of the year and is regularly reminded about them, but I wanted to ensure that you are also aware so you can support your child in meeting them. We don't want any child to be in the position where they want to go to the Summer Reward Event, but can't because they haven't met the criteria.

Criteria for attending the Summer Rewards Event

- Attend all GER sessions whenever possible
- Do Sparx maths each week night
- Do Tassomai each week night and achieve the daily goal
- Do all homework and achieve 80% or expected in progress checks
- Attend Champions Hour if the above is not achieved
- Attendance over 95%
- Behaviour ratio of 99% or better

If your child reaches all of these goals, they will be offered a place in the Year 11 Summer Event. If they don't meet these criteria and don't have a genuine reason, they will not be invited to the Summer Rewards Event.

However, for students who go above and beyond, they will be in our **Platinum Club** and their ticket for the Summer Rewards Event will be paid for by the school.

What does it take to be in the Platinum Club?

- Attend all GER sessions (if students present letters regarding medical appointments which stop them attending GER, these will not be counted as absences)
- Do Sparx maths each week night
- Do Tassomai each week night and achieve the daily goal
- Do all homework and achieve at least 80% or expected in progress checks
- Attend Champions Hour if the above is not achieved
- Attendance of 100%
- Behaviour ratio of 100%

Being in the **Platinum Club** requires a great deal of dedication from our students throughout the whole school year and having their ticket paid for is a just reward.

These students have

- Attended school every day, even on the days when they feel unwell and would prefer to stay at home.
- Turned up late to after school clubs and family events in order to attend
 Get Exam Ready every single day.
- Never missed a day completing Sparx and Tassomai.
- Behaved very well every single lesson of every single day and during their social time in school.
- Revised for their Progress Checks and Scored over 80%, or if they scored less than 80%, attended Champions Hours to catch up on the missed marks.
