Arrangements for September

Dear Parent/Carer

Firstly, I would like to welcome you all to Team Tanfield! The team is made up of our staff, all of your family, with your child at the centre. Over the next five years we will work together to ensure that your child leaves Tanfield School with the qualifications, skills and attributes they need to be successful in their next steps. We feel privileged that you and your child have chosen us.

As you know, due to the increasing number of Covid-19 cases in the area, we unfortunately needed to cancel the in school transition days. However, we hope that the transition hub has enabled you and your child to feel confident to join us in September. If you have not accessed this, then please see the details at the end of this letter to access it over the holiday.

I sincerely hope that from September we are able to resume as normal. However, as we have seen over the past 16 months the situation can change dramatically with very little notice. What we do know is that the DfE has stated that we need to test all of our students twice, three to five days apart, when returning to school. This is to ensure that we can keep your child, your family and all of our staff as safe as possible. This has and always will be our number one priority.

As your child has not been used to carrying out these tests, we are expecting the year 7 students to take a little longer when doing this for the first time. Therefore, we are going to ask for your child to come in at the following time to do their test on the 1st of September:

Surnames beginning with A to H to arrive between 9.30 and 10.30 Surnames beginning with I to P to arrive between 10.30 and 11.30 Surnames beginning with R to Z to arrive between 11.30 and 12.30

Students need to enter the school through the gate between the main building and the PE block. There will be staff present to direct them to the right place. They will only do their test on this day and then return home.

Their first full day will be the 2nd of September. They will need to arrive at school at 8.35am. Students need to arrive through the main entrance on this day. Again, we will have staff present to help direct them.


