Year 6 Transition to Tanfield School

Once again, I would like to welcome you all to Team Tanfield! We feel privileged that you and your child have chosen us.

At Tanfield, we feel that a combination of on-site and online activities will best support your child in their transition to Tanfield School. This means that as well as our on-site days - which we are very much looking forward to - we also have our online 'Year 6 Transition Hub' which can be accessed at any time from 23.5.25.

On-site Transition Days: Tuesday 1, Wednesday 2 and Thursday 3 July 2025.

Students will need to be dropped off and collected from the main yard of Tanfield school. It is the responsibility of parents/carers to drop off and pick up their child from Tanfield school. If you are happy for your child to make their own way to and from school we will need you to contact school and we will record your arrangement on our registers. Students will be given a group A-F and a number which will be emailed prior to Tuesday 1 July. This will be used to direct students to their line up for registration.
